

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING,
BOARD OF EDUCATION, SCHOOL
DISTRICT #225, COOK COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, JUNE 7, 1993**

A special meeting of the Board of Education, School District No. 225 was held on Monday, June 7, 1993 at approximately 2:10 p.m. at Glenbrook South High School, 4000 W. Lake Avenue, Glenview, pursuant to due notice to all members and the public.
