The president called the meeting to order and announced the reasons for the special meeting of the Board of Education. DISCUSSION REGARDING BOARD GOALS FOR 1999-2000

Discussion centered around district goal No. 2 which deals with the demographic study and possible boundary changes in the district. The superintendent reviewed issues from the previous boundary study, which was conducted during the summer and fall of 1994. The superintendent and administrative staff then discussed preliminary information regarding the following four issues that were requested by the school board in December when the demographic study was initially presented:

1. Study the impact designating the anticipated 100/167 high school students from The Glen to attend Glenbrook North instead of Glenbrook South.
2. Study the impact of different schedules that could improve building capacity.
