

BOARD POLICY: RELIGION AND EDUCATION

7360

Section A

It is the policy of the Board of Education of District #225 to prohibit religious instruction in the schools while school is in session and when such instruction promotes a particular religion or religious sect or constitutes a religious service. This is distinguished from in-class instruction by staff or resource persons whose sole purpose is to inform students of the beliefs of a particular religious group or to point out historical or sociological affects of a particular religion or religious sect.

Section B

Temporary rentals may be made to religious organizations or sectarian groups for religious services or education when the facilities are not being used for the regular school program. (See Board Policy: Community Use of School Facilities (5030).
