

BOARD POLICY: PROTECTIVE EYE DEVICES

8220

Section A

The Glenbrook schools will comply with all laws, rules, and regulations relating to the Eye Protection in School Act.

The instructional supervisors and teachers shall be responsible for assuring that appropriate safety procedures are followed in accordance with the law and State Board of Education standards.

Protective eye devices shall be available for purchase by students in the school bookstores and shall be provided to all visitors when participating in or observing dangerous vocational arts and chemical-physical courses as specified in the Eye Protection in School Act.

Students may wear regular glasses as safety glasses provided that the lenses meet the standards prescribed by the American Standards Association Safety Code for head, eye, and respiratory protection.
