

BOARD POLICY: **CONCERNS REGARDING CURRICULUM OR RELATED**
INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

Section A

The Board of Education recognizes its complex and difficult task to educate all students in the community. To this end, the Board of Education shall provide educational experiences through a systematic series of required and elective curricular offerings. The Board of Education realizes the value and necessity to consider concerns regarding curriculum from a variety of sources before making judgments regarding curriculum matters.

Section B

The final decision for all curricular matters shall rest with the Board of Education. The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to determine the nature or variety of curricular offerings. , The Board will not relinquish that responsibility, nor will it allow a citizen, parent, or group of citizens to determine the nature or content of a course or to restrict students other than their own children from enrolling in an elective course.

Section C

All course deletions, additions, or revisions that change the nature of a course shall be approved by the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the superintendent in accordance with Board Policy: Curriculum Planning Strategy (7010). The final decision for the removal or the revision of a course shall rest with the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the superintendent after careful examination and discussion of the course content with school officials or anyone else the Board of Education may wish to involve.

Section D

Concerns regarding curriculum offerings or related instructional materials should be made in writing to the appropriate building principal in accordance with the procedures of this policy..
