

Preparation for College Training

Before your DRS College case can be reviewed and considered for financial support, there are several pieces of information that you must prepare, collect and provide to Terri Michaels, NNSSED/DRS Transition Specialist.

Please prepare a narrative essay, to include the following required information:

1. *College and expected course of study:* Identify the college where you plan to enroll and your intended course of study.
2. *Description and justification of employment goal:* Describe the type of job you expect to obtain from the training you receive in college.
3. *As appropriate, include additional information:* Describe any personal interests, involvement in school or community-based clubs or organizations and/or employment history.

Complete the following:

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA): Obtain the application at or from the college's financial aid department.

Attach the following:

Narrative essay

Acceptance letter from the college you plan to attend

FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)

Financial Aid Award letter from the school you are attending (college or university will provide this letter, which should include the amount of financial support, scholarships, grants, etc. student will receive)

Family's tax returns or W-2 (if attending 4-year College or trade school)

Transcripts or grade report (including your G.P.A)

SAT and/or ACT scores

Deadline to submit documents for determination of DRS college support by 5/1/2014
