BOARD POLICY: PRE-SCHOOL

7350

Section A

District #225 shall permit the operation of a pre-school program in the Glenbrook District for the purpose of providing laboratory experiences for Glenbrook students enrolled in Child

Development classes.

Section B

The superintendent, or his designated representative, shall formulate criteria for the selection of pre-school children (3 and 4 year olds) for the program. Generally, selection shall be on an annual basis from children of the community in order of application. An initial September enrollment of at least 12 children will be required.

Pre-school children enrolled in the program shall be under the supervision of an adult professional or paraprofessional staff member. Pre-school children may not be taken off the Glenbrook

campus by staff members or Glenbrook students.

Section C

Transportation between the child's home and Glenbrook shall be provided by the child's parents.

Section E

Tuition shall be charged for students enrolled in the pre school program at a rate to be approved annually by the Board of Education.
